REQUIRED ASM AUTOCAD STANDARDS

1. The Property Boundary Line must be Blue and in a layer called BNDY. Other lines are to be in the following colors and linetypes:

Utility Lines are to be polylines containing text or symbols that reference the utility they represent. Examples as shown below:

All layers are to be named with the appropriate name describing what the line represents. Examples:

Description	Layer Name

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

2. The Text Style is to be Leroy and the font used is simplex.shx. Below are examples:

Style Name	When used	Text Height
L80	ALL BASIC TEXT TIES	0.08 X SCALE
L100	IMPORTANT TEXT SURVEY NOTES BOUNDARY CURVE TABLE ACREAGE PARCEL DESIGNATION (SECTION NUMBER, UPLAND, WETLAND, ETC)	0.10 X SCALE
L120	BOUNDARY LABEL TEXT	0.12 X SCALE
L140	STREET NAME	0.14 X SCALE

The smallest text height allowed on a drawing is L80 or 0.08 x scale.

- 3. All bearings, distances and reference calls contained in the Title Description must be shown or referenced on the survey. This applies for the subject property, less out parcels and easements contained in the Title Description.
- 4. The Schedule B-II Items are to be typed out in the Schedule B-II Items box word for word as shown in the title commitment with the item number referenced. All exceptions are to be shown on the survey or noted that they are not plottable. All text is to be in the color red and double circles around the item number. See below for examples:



The double circled item number is also to be shown on the survey where the easement is located, so the Schedule B-II exception in the box can be references on the drawing itself.

5. Only use symbols or abbreviations if needed because of space issues. Make sure that all symbols and abbreviations used are listed in the Legend. Only symbols or abbreviations that are used are to be shown in the Legend, if they are not referenced in the survey delete.



6. The Possible Encroachment List is to be in red and the letters used to reference the location on the survey circled. The encroachment notes should describe the type of encroachment and give an "at most" dimension of the encroachment. See below for example.

POSSIBLE ENCROACHMENT LIST

- A SIDEWALK ENCROACHES INTO SUBJECT PROPERTY BY AT MOST 5.3'.
- B BUILDING IS AT MOST 1.2' INTO BUILDING SETBACKS.
- 7. Xref's and raster images (tiff's, jpeg's, bmp's, etc...) are not acceptable, including for the vicinity map.
